An error occurred in the commentary by Schroeder and Roberts, titled “Is Tradition Trumping Evidence in the Treatment of Young, Febrile Infants?” published in the April issue of *Hospital Pediatrics* (2016;6[4]:252–253; doi: 10.1542/hpeds.2016-0013). On page 252, in paragraph 1, the second sentence began, “Traditional teaching is that the 3 most common pathogens in neonatal sepsis are *Escherichia coli*, group B *Streptococcus* (GBS), and *Listeria*...” It should have read, “Traditional teaching is that the 3 most common pathogens in neonatal sepsis are group B *Streptococcus* (GBS), *Escherichia coli*, and *Listeria*...” The fourth sentence began, “GBS has now surpassed *E. coli*...” It should have read, “*E. coli* has now surpassed GBS...” These errors were corrected in the online article of record.
