The American Academy of Pediatrics is calling for nominations for the position of editor in chief for the journal *Hospital Pediatrics*. This is a three-year term of service to begin July 2021, with eligibility for a second three-year term. Candidates are expected to be leaders in their field and a visionary, as the publication landscape is experiencing rapid changes in scientific content delivery.

Hospital Pediatrics is dedicated to the health and well-being of all children in the hospital setting. *Hospital Pediatrics* is an official, peer-reviewed journal of the American Academy of Pediatrics. The journal publishes original research and other article types that educate and inform readers of quality, safety, research, and clinical practice advancements relevant to the field.

Goals of the position:

- Provide leadership for the journal.
- Be innovative and a visionary in the field to move the journal forward.
- Manage the executive and general boards, including chairing the annual editorial board meeting.
- Maintain scientific standards of the journal.
- Identify emerging areas of importance and solicit papers for submission.
- Write editorials that discuss pertinent issues to hospital medicine.
- Commit 20%-30% of time and effort monthly.
